

INTEGRATED 3 and 4 year old PRESCHOOL PROGRAM 2016-2017*

The Woodbury Heights School District will be offering a **NEW** Integrated Preschool Program for the school year for **3 and 4 year-old** students that is tuition based. This program gives your 3 or 4 year old the benefit of being in their home school district for an additional year or two of learning.

This half-day program will be offered five days per week with either a morning (8:30 am to 11:00 am) or an afternoon session (12:45 pm to 3:15 pm).

Eligible children must be three years of age by October 1, 2016. Children cannot be older than five years of age by October 1, 2016. No transportation or additional childcare will be provided. Children must be toilet-trained, have up-to-date immunizations, and should have age-appropriate verbal skills.

Interested families should come to the school's main office for a registration packet between 8:00 am and 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Completed packets must be returned in person before March 18th. If the number of applicants exceeds the number of available openings, a public lottery will be held to determine entry into the program. School officials will draw numbers during the lottery, which will be held on Monday, April 4, 2016 at 9:00 am in the main office at Woodbury Heights Elementary School.

Our office will notify you during the week of April 4, 2016 as to whether there is a program opening for your child. Subsequently, an Enrollment Commitment Form will be mailed to you. Please return your completed form along with the **\$25.00** administrative fee. Tuition for the program is **\$250.00 per month** and will be automatically withdrawn by the Business Office via Electronic Fund Transfer from an account designated by you.
